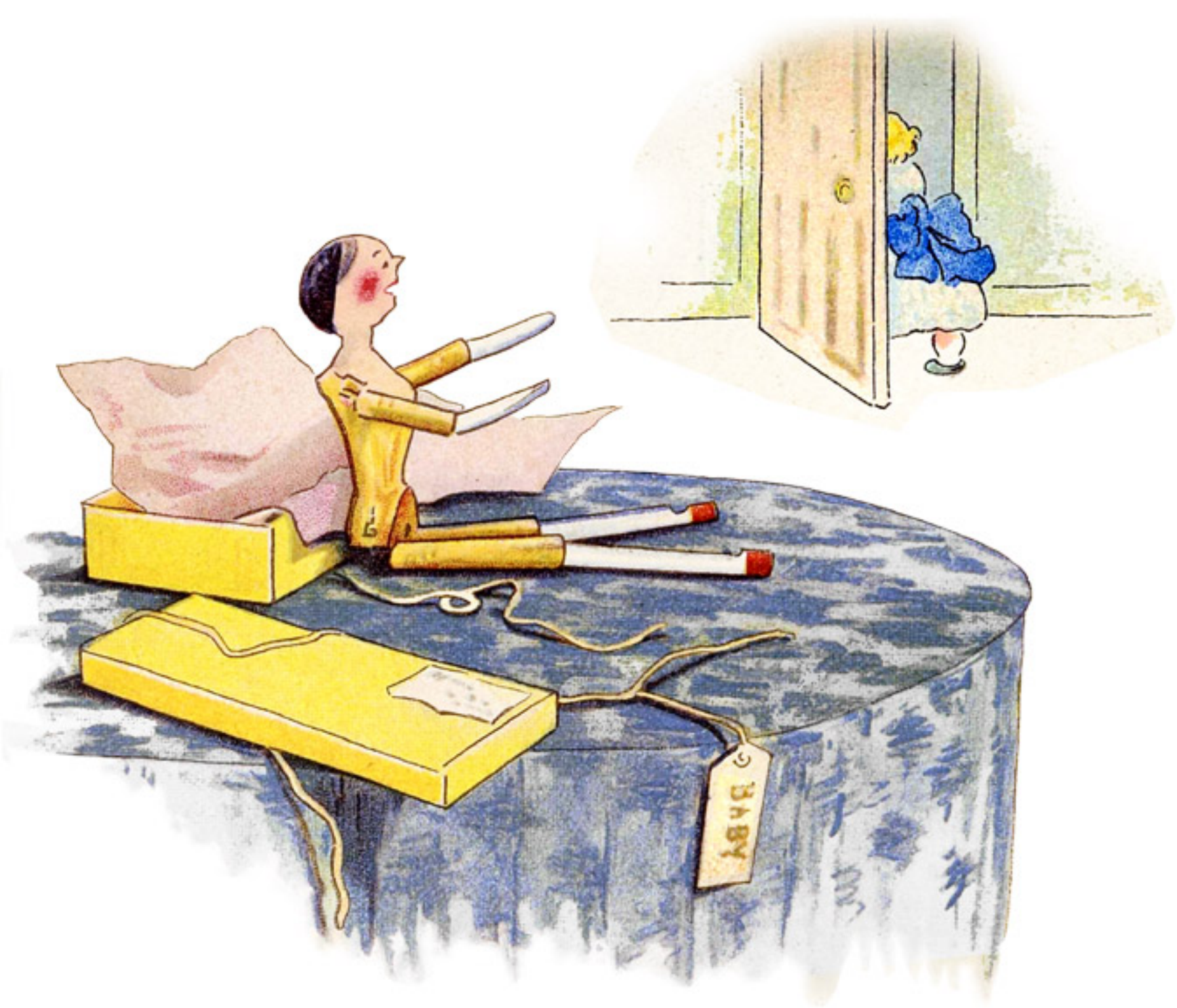

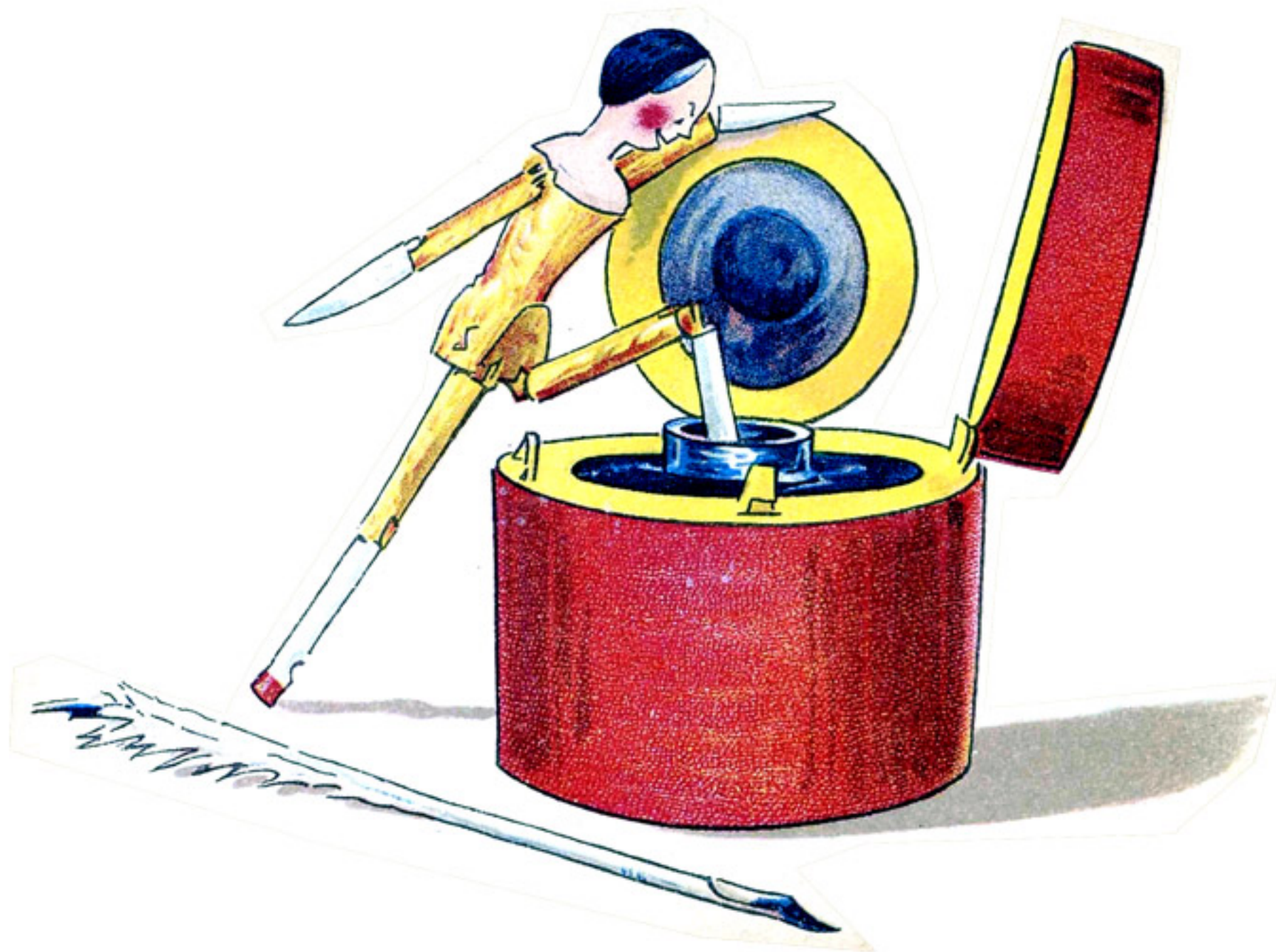

*x x x x x*

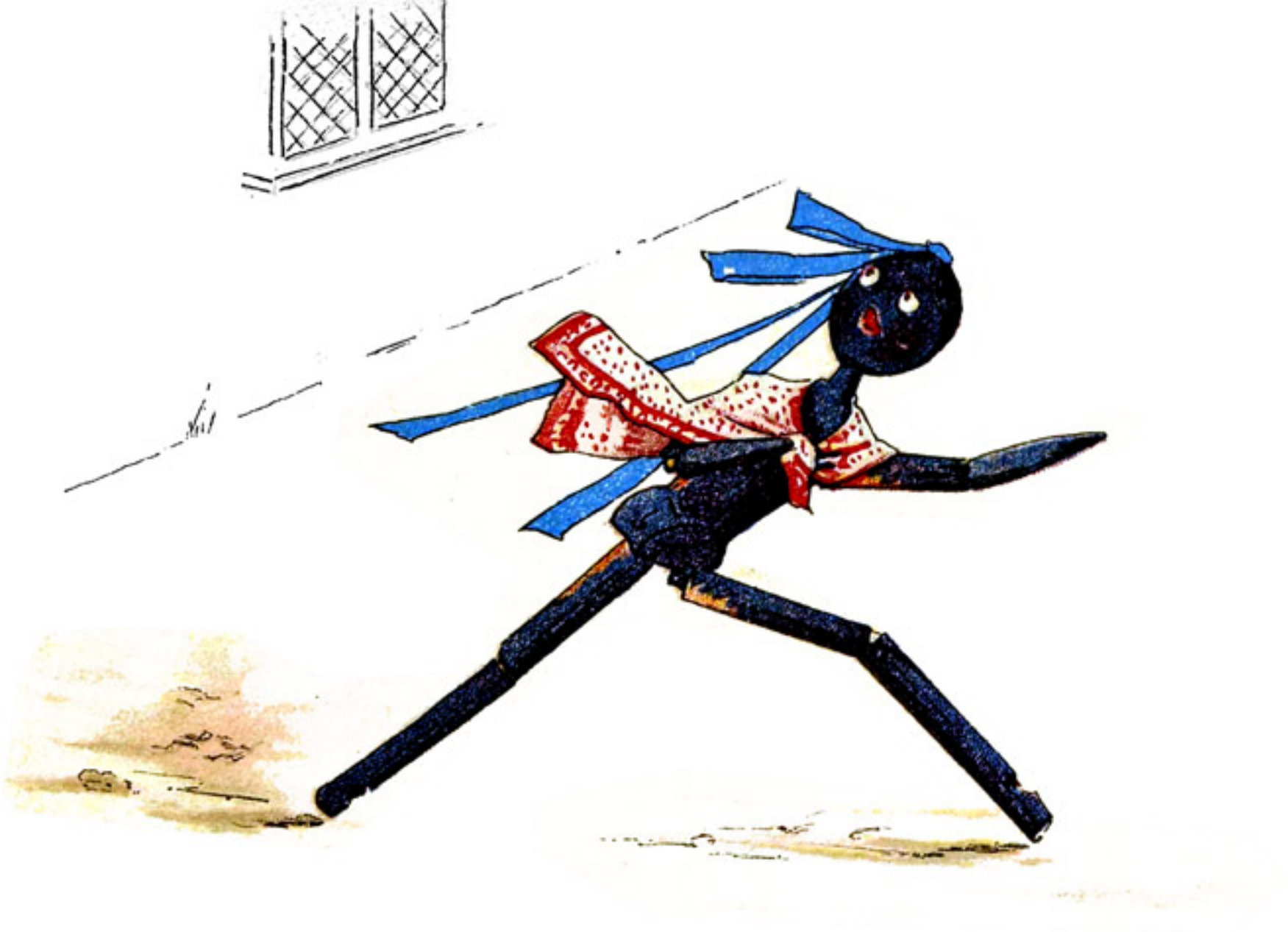
*“O, what a mess!!!

to find Baby.*



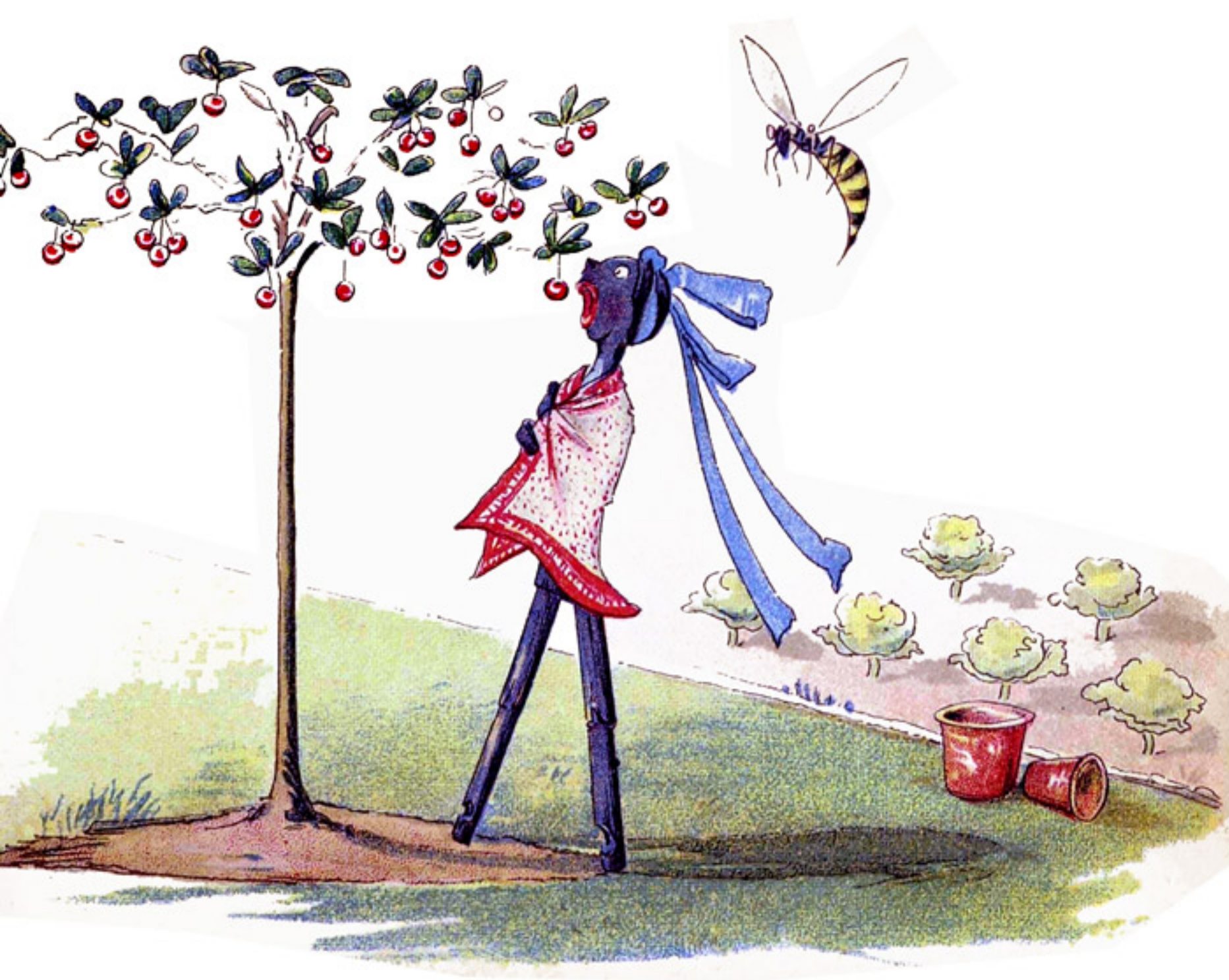
*Is she in the field?*

me up.*

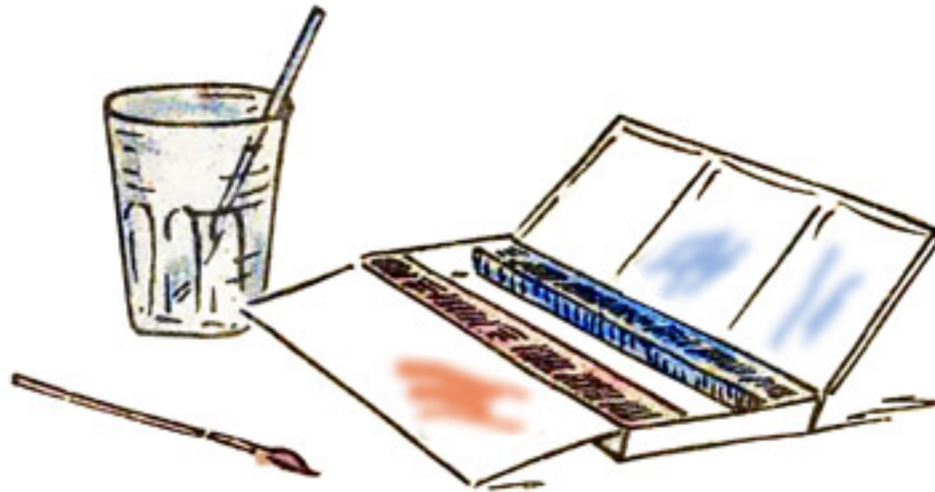
*“Look Nursie – what a
