**SOS CHILDREN'S VILLAGES**

A loving home for every child

Around the world children's lives are shattered by poverty, disease, conflict and natural disasters.

SOS Children gives orphans and abandoned children a loving home and a family for life in one of our Children's Villages. We make sure that children have healthcare and education. We support struggling families in the communities where we work in an effort to reduce instances of child abandonment and neglect.

SOS Children is the UK centre for the work of SOS Children's Villages, an international, non-governmental development organisation. We are part of a federation of autonomous national associations which are separate legal entities. Each member association complies with our international statutes. The International Secretariat, based in Innsbruck, oversees all programme development and establishes international principles.

**70%**

70% of children living in SOS families in Kenya and Malawi have been orphaned, in most cases because of HIV/AIDS.

**72%**

In Laos 72%, in India 30% and in Zimbabwe 66% of children in SOS families are from families where both parents have died.

**44%**

In 44% of cases in Chile the main reason for children being placed in the care of SOS families is neglect.

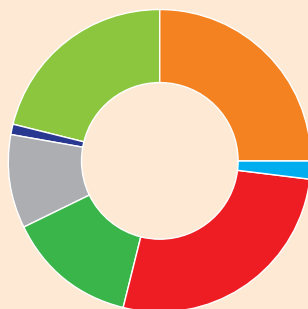
**60%**

Of children living in the care of SOS families in Finland, 60% are from families where the parents are struggling with alcohol or drug addiction.

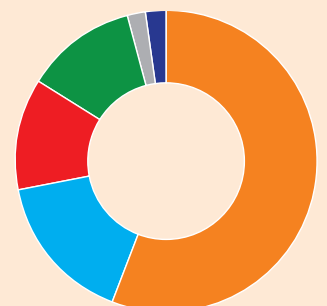
