Title	Where In The World?		
Summary	A locational quiz – can the young people identify the continent that the countries are in? This idea can be used as a quick, standalone activity or as part of a session which also combines the SOS Happy Families Find Someone activity.		

## **Details**

## Resources:

- SOS Happy Families cards
- Where in the World labels (same number of sets as there are teams)
- world map (optional)

## Activity:

- 1. Divide the young people into teams.
- 2. Line the teams up at one end of the room. Place the labels at the other end of the room, a set for each team.
- 3. Share the Happy Families cards out between the teams. If they are already familiar with the cards you can go straight into playing the game, if not, maybe give them a few minutes to look at and share the information on the cards amongst their team.
- 4. At the blow of a whistle, the game begins. Run the activity like a relay race; the first team member runs to the other end of the room with a card. When they get there, they have to make a decision about which continent the country is in and place it by the right continent label.
- 5. The team member runs back to rejoin their team, and the next person takes their turn.
- 6. When all the cards are placed, count up the ones which were correctly placed, perhaps giving them 1 point each and offering 5 points for the team who finished first.
- 7. Spend some time looking at a world map and finding the places on the cards.
